“SYDNEY HARBOUR YHA” 110-128 CUMBERLAND ST, THE ROCKS

Dear **Resident**,

Please be advised that construction of the new ‘Sydney Harbour YHA’ at 110 - 128 Cumberland St is about to start.

This site has undergone detailed archaeological excavation over the last 15 years which has uncovered remnants of buildings that date back to very early European settlers.

Built NSW Pty Ltd has been awarded the construction contract. Built will endeavour to keep you informed of all major disruption that will occur prior to the date, to allow you to make any necessary arrangements if you wish.

The first major disruption to occur will take place on **Monday 15th and Tuesday 16th** September 2008. A full road closure is required for Gloucester St, from Cumberland St down to the end of the street. This is required so that a mobile crane can be set up to install the two tower cranes that will be put on the site. This cannot be done from Cumberland St as through traffic must be maintained on this street at all times. These cranes will mean that all materials handling can be carried out via the Cumberland Street Works Zone.

Built understand that many residents park their cars in Gloucester St and that this closure will cause inconvenience to some. The installation of the cranes requires that **Gloucester St is clear of all vehicles** as this will be a very large operation that requires the full width of the street. Built have contacted the city rangers and have confirmed that your residents permits are valid for parking on Cumberland St for these days.

Built apologise for any inconvenience caused but believe that the installation of these two cranes will greatly reduce construction vehicles from being in Gloucester St for the duration of the project.
